ABOUT THE DIRECTORS

LINDSAY DORIS

Lindsay began her dance training at the age of 7 in Scottsdale, AZ. Lindsay's dance training was as unique as it included the opportunity to be a competitive dancer as well as trained in the classical forms of ballet and modern dance. This cross-section of dance education inspired her to continue on in dance as a career. At the age of 16, she was accepted into the prestigious University of North Carolina School of the Arts (UNCSA) where she received her high school diploma and Bachelor of Fine Arts in Contemporary Dance. At UNCSA she experienced working with the choreography of such greats as Jose Limon, Lar Lubovitch and Alwin Nikolais. Following her graduation from UNCSA, Lindsay continued her dance education at The Limon School, The Paul Taylor School, The Merce Cunningham School and the Peridance Capezio Center. It was through a class at Peridance that Lindsay gained her entry into the professional dance world and became a member of the Cleo Mack Dance Project. It was during her final year with the company that she decided teaching dance was her true passion and she leapt into the world of teaching full force.



DANA MILLETTE

At the age of 2 1/2, Dana was diagnosed with a brain tumor that nearly caused her to lose her life. Although most of the tumor was successfully removed, her neurologists were concerned that what remained might continue to grow and affect her coordination. To offset that possibility her parents enrolled her in dance classes and thankfully she made a full recovery. Since beginning her dance training at the age of 3, she has had the opportunity to study various forms of dance including Broadway-style tap and the ballet syllabus of the Royal Academy of Dance as well as perform as a competitive dancer. At age 17, Dana was nominated for a prestigious Papermill Playhouse Rising Star Award for her choreography in her high school's production of "The Music Man." After graduating high school Dana went on to receive her Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance from Rutgers University Mason Gross School of the Arts (MGSA). While at MGSA she was a member of University Danceworks which gave her the opportunity to work with many well-known choreographers. She then went on to study massage therapy in order to increase her knowledge of anatomy and injury prevention. It was at a very young age that Dana knew teaching dance was her life's dream and is thrilled to bring the love and appreciation of dance into the hearts of young children each and every day.
